As you know, Special Olympics was born in Chicago at Soldier Field in July 1968 and since has grown into a worldwide movement engaging millions of children and adults with intellectual disabilities. In April, we released a video called "Special Olympics - Born in Chicago." It has reached more than 2 million people, has been viewed more than 52,000 times and continues to be shared across Facebook, Twitter and YouTube. It features an athlete who competed in the first Special Olympics games in 1968 and continues to compete today, and Justice Anne Burke, who was the visionary for Special Olympics 50 years ago.
